



Fifth	Write a 3 paragraph reflection describing what you chose and why, the process of completion, and how working on this project felt.


Project Ideas

Reading Comprehension & Fluency Tips for




* Before Reading

Brainstorm-What do you know about this subject? What do you Browse- Take a picture walk through the story to get an idea of what it might be about. Point to any tricky words and sound them out to make sure you understand them before you begin reading. hope to learn?

Predict-What do you think will happen in this story? Question-Who? What? When? Where? Why? How?



Fluency- Are you reading in a manner that sounds like natural Summarize-What has happened in the story so far? Question-Who? What? When? Where? Why? How? Predict - What do you think will happen next? Kercad- Did what you just read make sense? speech?



Renead-Read it again faster and for a better understanding? Confirm- Were your predictions about the story correct? Question- Who? What? When? Where? Why? How?
