The AP US Government and Political CED states that, "Foundational documents are necessary for students to understand the philosophical underpinnings and political values of the U.S. political system and may serve as the focus of AP Exam questions." One of the most important foundational documents of this course is the U.S. Constitution. We will be using the Constitution throughout the entirety of this year. We will also be using the Constitution Center often so go ahead and bookmark it. To get familiar with the Constitution, put each section and amendment into your own words. You can use the headings and interpretations to help you but make sure you know what each part really means.

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
